



NCHS 2021 CONSERVATION GRANTS

DUE NOVEMBER 1, 2020

The Northern California Herpetological Society will be providing grants to individuals or groups seeking to obtain funding for reptile or amphibian focused conservation projects. These grants can be the sole funding for a project or used to fund one or more aspects of a larger project.

Graduate students and professionals: \$1,000 (Up to 2 grants awarded)

Undergraduate students: \$500 (Up to 2 grants awarded)

Kindergarten through high school students and classrooms: \$250 (Up to 2 grants awarded)

DETAILS:

- Projects must be located in California.
- Applications are due no later than 11:59pm on November 1, 2020. Late applications will not be considered. Submit to norcalherp@gmail.com.
- Awards will be announced by December 15, 2020.
- Awards will be disbursed by December 31, 2020.
- Please keep applications short, not to exceed two pages.
- Include in your two page limit a detailed description of how you would like to use the grant money. It is possible to apply for less than the full grant amount offered if you do not need the full sum, please specify.
- Projects should take place in 2021 or starting in 2021. Please include a timeline goal.
- Please state if you would be willing to give NCHS a presentation about your conservation project. Ability or willingness to present is not a requirement to be considered.

Applications will be reviewed and voted on by NCHS Board Members. NCHS Board Members and their family are not eligible. NCHS may award grants less or more in number or monetary value than advertised depending on number and quality of applications received.
